OVERVIEW


The Library works in partnership with the States Health Visiting Team to give a free bag of books to every child in the Bailiwick at their 8-month, 2-year, and 3-year health checks.

The bags also contain rhyming sheets as well as information and advice on early literacy for parents.

IMPACT

In Guernsey the average birth rate is 600/year. All of these children receive a book bag at each of their three health checks before starting school.

Building literacy and encouraging reading in the early years is crucially important: it develops language skills, sparks imagination and creativity, and boosts cognitive development. In other words, reading is good for you! It's also vitally important to children's futures. Research shows that:

- Children who engage with books and nursery rhymes during their first '1001 Critical Days' (from conception to age 2) have **consistently better outcomes** than those that don't.
- Reading for pleasure is the single most important indicator of a child's future success – more important than their family background. Children who read for pleasure have a better sense of wellbeing, have better self-esteem, and achieve greater levels of attainment in all subjects – they simply do better in life.

Sadly, many children don't have access to books at home. These book bags encourage families to read with their little ones and to use the Library, which is free and open to all.
