The cases will enable the Library to exhibit rare books and other artefacts on a regular basis, enriching Guernsey's cultural life and improving public access to the Island's heritage.

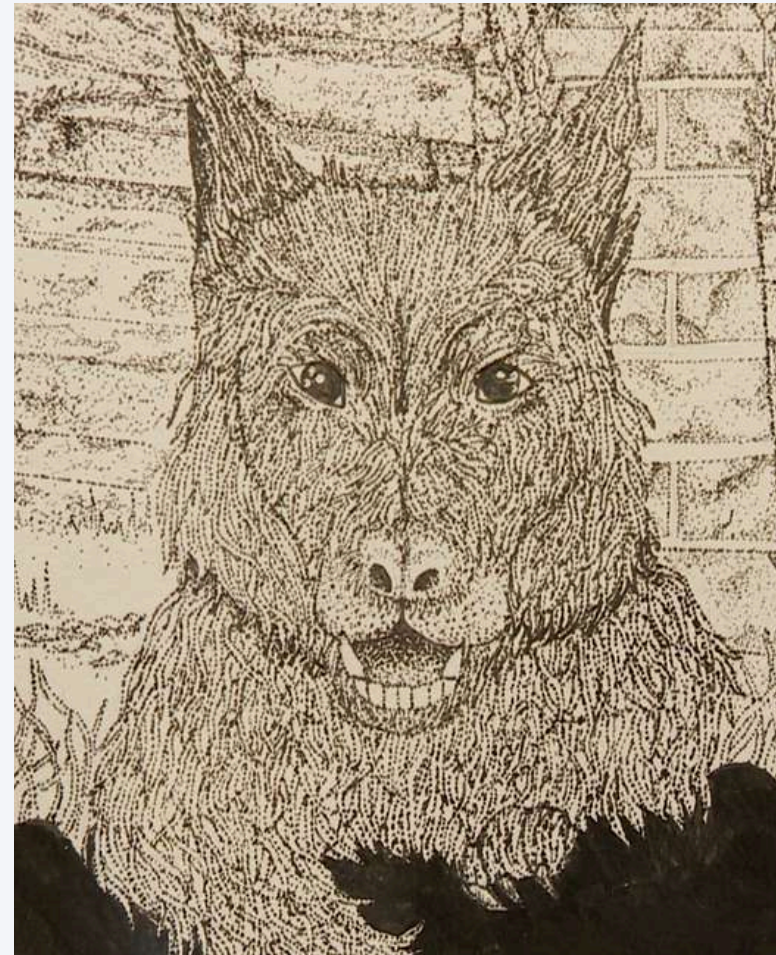

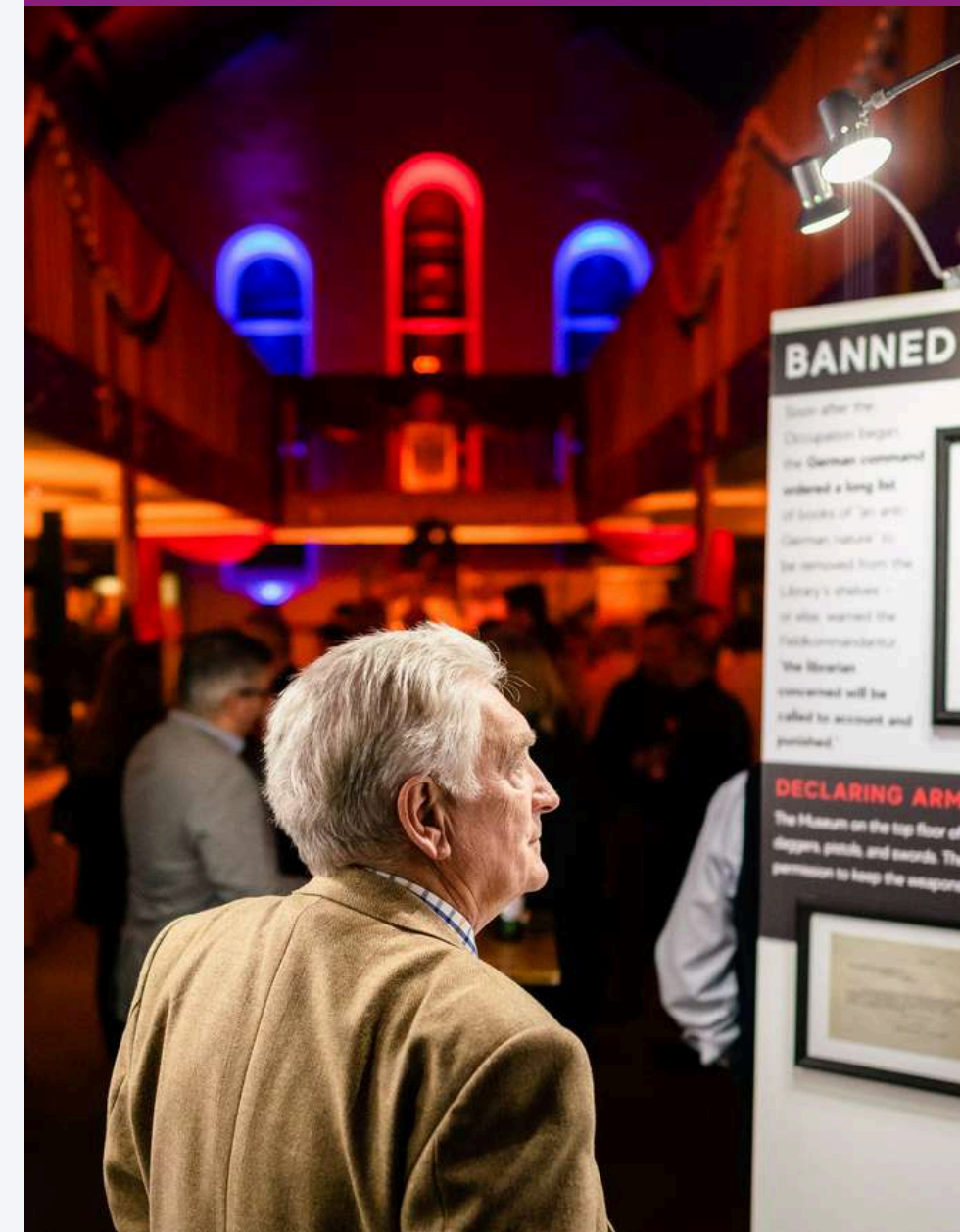

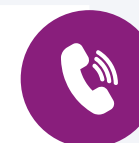
