The Library runs an extremely popular service called Tea & Tales, which sees staff visit local care homes to read stories aloud and encourage conversation about what they've read.

#### **IMPACT**

At Tea & Tales, attendees listen to stories read by Library staff, then afterwards enjoy a cup of tea and a chat about what they heard. Developed with input from care home staff and partner organisations including Dementia Friendly Guernsey, the sessions are focused around specific themes – 'schooldays', 'family history', and so on – and concentrate on stories with a local connection. Staff bring the stories to life by passing around props and even dressing up. The stories, particularly the local elements, often trigger memories and spark interaction.

Tea & Tales keeps care home residents connected to the Library and engaged in reading, and helps to combat loneliness. It's an opportunity to socialise, while at the same time maintaining cognitive health. Care home staff report that it engages even their residents who never participate in anything else, and in some cases rarely speak.

There are now monthly sessions in seven different care homes, reaching more than 100 older adults in total. The programme has recently been integrated into the Guernsey Literary Festival, and the librarian behind it has been shortlisted for a prestigious national award for her work.
